The practice patient group which was formed by the practice consists of 2 from our branch surgery at Ednam Road Practice, 1 from Pendeford Practice and 3 from our main surgery at Whitmore Reans Health Practice.

The main objective of the PPG is to consult and plan with patients on the facilities and provision of services and ways on how to improve our services available to the satisfaction of patients.

The aim of the PPG is

- The Group to advise on day to day functioning of the practice
- To improve network with the carers and patients
- Host health awareness events such as Breast Cancer Evening and Diabetes day

The meetings will be held 3 monthly and we will try to cater for patients with varying needs for example by communicating by phone or e-mail.

Three Key areas were identified where agreed where practice could improve.

- Separate telephone lines will be made available for appointments only.
- Methods of improving prescription requests in the practice.
- Consultation time: It was agreed that clinicians in the practice will be advised on improving their consultation skills to match the needs of the patients.
