Welcome to Independence Support (ISL)

We are a Cheshire East based support provider.

We operate a Crisis Café in Crewe to provide a safe, welcoming and comfortable space away from a clinical environment for people in crisis, and those seeking to prevent the onset of a crisis. The onsite team will provide emotional support and resilience building as well as support people to develop positive relationships.

We can also provide practical advice and signposting. Where needed we will support people in a mental health crisis to access other support.

- * The service will work closely with the Crisis Home Treatment Team and the 24 hour crisis line
- * The café will provide beverages plus hot and cold snacks
