### Update on Our Services - from David Harvey, CEO

In January 2025, after 7 years, the Cheshire West Carer Support Service will come to an end. During this time the service has supported more than 10,000 carers across Cheshire West and Chester through ourselves and our local partner organisations, The Alzheimer's Society, The BREN Project, Crossroads Together, Making Space, Neuromuscular Centre and OPAL.

Cheshire West and Chester Council are currently commissioning a new Community Led Care and Carers (CLCC) Service which will include support for carers, along with older adults and a hospital discharge service. This development will result in a number of changes to how carers are supported going forward. Whilst we hope that Cheshire and Warrington Carers Trust will be involved in this new service, at this stage we are still in the bidding process.

We will, of course, communicate any updates on our website, regular email blog, and by post to carers without access to the internet.

Over the next four months we will continue to provide a full range of support for carers across the borough including activities to recognise Carers Rights Day in November, to celebrate both our 30th Anniversary and Christmas activities.

### **Carers Rights Day**

Carers Rights Day this year is on Thursday 21st November 2024. We will be hosting an information and support lunch in the Chester area alongside a number of smaller events across the borough. It is important that carers recognise that they have rights around employment, access to services, and recognition of their role.

### **Working Carer Support**

If you are balancing a job and caring responsibilities, you will understand the difficulty of managing both roles. To support working carers, alongside our one to one support sessions, we host regular group evening meals on the second and fourth Thursdays of the month at 6pm (refer to dates on P4 & P5). These gatherings provide an opportunity for working carers to connect, exchange stories, and offer advice to each other.



We offer a range of services outside of typical working hours to help support working carers. Please make contact with us if you need a flexible appointment to fit around your work commitments. Additionally, you can find a wealth of helpful resources for working carers on the Carers UK website. Simply visit www.carersuk.org and search 'work and career' for the latest information on your rights, communicating with your employer, carers' leave, transitioning out of work, and much more.

### **Carers Assessments**

Cheshire and Warrington Carers Trust are commissioned to complete Carer Assessments on behalf of Cheshire West and Chester Council. This assessment gives carers the chance to tell us what they need, and to find out what support might be available.

The Carers assessment explores whether you as a carer have eligible needs in your own right. This assessment will consider the impact of caring. It will also consider what difficulties you may be facing, how you manage them and the things that you want to achieve in your day-to-day life.

### **Community Home First**

Community Home First has now been working on this project for six months and have supported over 80 carers looking after a relative coming home from either The Countess of Chester or Leighton Hospital. We are working in partnership with Snow Angels, Age UK and Cheshire Community Action. We have recently been informed that this service will now continue until the end of 2025.


## **Our 30th Anniversary Year**
