If you need medical assistance when we are closed you can contact 111.


Latest News

Flu & COVID Vaccination Programme

The **Flu and COVID vaccination** programme will launch on Thursday 3rd October 2024 in Ellesmere Port town centre.

The clinics will be held in two locations:

Weekdays: Civic Hall, Ellesmere Port Saturdays: Old Job Centre, Port Arcades

Respiratory Syncytial Virus (RSA)

RSV is a very common virus, but some can become seriously ill. The virus can lead to Bronchiolitis in children and Pneumonia in children and adults. It is responsible for large numbers of hospital admissions during the winter months.

NHS England have launched a vaccination programme starting in September to vaccinate those most at risk of becoming seriously ill or at risk of hospitalisation should they contract the virus. You will be eligible if you are 28+ weeks pregnant (to protect unborn child) or aged 75 – 80 years old.

We will be holding vaccination clinics in Ellesmere Port Town Centre in September for eligible patients.
