3. Well Being Nurse

Most Tuesdays the Well Being Nurse comes into the Practice. These appointments are made via the Well Being Nurse and GP Referrals only.

4. Community Wellbeing

Twice a week the Community Wellbeing Officer comes into the Practice. The Community Wellbeing Officer can provide personalised 1-to-1 support and/or group interventions to improve your wellbeing

Other Services

In order to provide a better, more comprehensive service to our patients, we have a number of other primary care staff who provide clinics and services from within St Pauls Health Centre, but are not employed by the Practice. This leaflet gives details of these services.

Some of are these services are provided through the Community clinic. Their reception is based to the left of the main entrance and they deal with the following services:

Midwives

Most of the routine care and checks for pregnant women are a carried out at the surgery by fully trained midwives. For your first appo

trained midwives. For your first appointment with the midwife (if you have not been referred by the GP) you need to complete a self referral form for midwifery services, these are available at the Practice's reception. Once completed please pass back to our receptionists and the midwife will contact you with your first appointment date. All future appointments will be booked via your midwife direct.

Other services within St Pauls Health Centre are:

1. Physiotherapist

Once a week the physiotherapist holds a session. These appointments are only available when your GP has referred you for physiotherapy or you have self referred. These appointments are usually booked for you by Halton Hospital physiotherapy department.

2. Phlebotomist

You are able to have your blood tests done every day at the surgery by making an appointment.
