Patient feedback

It also gives us an opportunity to provide an explanation if something hasn't gone as well as you would have liked. We have a feedback box on the

GP Contract 2024/2025

We have received information from the NHS about the contract for this year. The themes continue from last year:

Empowering patients

- Enabling patients to view their medical records online. We went live with this last summer.
- Online ordering of repeat prescriptions. We regularly promote this.
- Ability to book appointments online e.g. the recent Covid Clinics were sent out with a link to book an appointment direct without having to call the Practice.

<u>Implementing Modern General Practice</u> <u>Access</u>

- We went live with our new telephone system in March 2024 which provides patients with the option of a call back rather than waiting in a queue.
- We continue to develop our care navigation by signposting you to the most appropriate service. We also have an Advanced Nurse Practitioner who will triage appointment requests. Again with the aim of getting patients the

most appropriate appointment as quickly as possible.

Building capacity in our workforce

 We have a new three year strategy for the Practice (more later) which includes succession planning and sustainability of the Practice

Cutting bureaucracy

 There is a lot of work underway in the NHS to improve the referral processes between primary (GPs) and secondary (hospitals and specialists) care.

Research study

Greenmoss has joined a national study looking at certain viruses with the aim to learn more about these and how to help prevent them.

We are asking patients who come to see us with a chest or respiratory problem if we can take a swab which we then send off to the research company. The results help the researchers understand more about different types of virus and as a patient you will receive the results from the swab so that you have more information about your condition. This is completely voluntary.

Car park

Can we remind patients that the car park is for patients coming in to the Practice. The top car park should <u>not</u> be used by parents dropping off or picking up children from the local school. We have limited spaces and it is not fair to our patients. The bottom car park is currently available for parents to use.
