### Respiratory syncytial virus RSV vaccinations

This is a new vaccination. We are vaccinating in September 2024. We will contact you if you are eligible for this vaccination. There are two types:

#### Older adults aged 75 to 79 years old

All adults turning 75 years old on or after 1 September 2024 up to 79 years old will be eligible and will be offered the RSV vaccine.

#### Pregnant women to protect infants

All women who are at least 28 weeks pregnant on 1 September 2024, will be offered the vaccine. After that, pregnant women are eligible as they reach 28 weeks gestation and remain eligible up to the birth.

Our next monthly dog walk will be on 14<sup>th</sup> September 2023, meeting at the Wilbraham Ams car park in Alsager at 11am. Please come along if you fancy a walk, with or without a dog. This will be the last dog walk for this year. We'll start again in spring 2025.
