Who is a Carer?

Carers provide support to someone who needs extra help to manage day-to-day life. A carer is someone who, without payment, provides help and support to a partner, child, relative, friend, or neighbour who could not manage without their help. This could be due to age, physical or mental illness, addiction or disability.

Why should my GP surgery know I am a Carer?

All GP surgeries in Cheshire West and Chester record the names of carers. This information can help your surgery to:

- Early intervention of carer health problems may lead to faster treatment and improved health outcomes.
- Timely identification and registration of carers to make it easier to offer health checks and screening, flu jabs, to maintain good physical & mental health.
- Improving physical health and emotional wellbeing of carers can lead to reduced demands on services and also may lead to saving in a GP's prescribing budget.

Cheshire and Warrington Carers Trust is the lead provider of Cheshire West Carer Support Services. We have resource centres in Northwich and Chester to provide the core elements of the service such as:
