NHS App


Social Prescribers

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Flu & RSV Vaccinations

Flu season is now upon us and we have started to contact eligible patients to book into our clinics. If you are eligible and have not yet been contacted please ring the practice after 10am for an appointment.



RSV vaccines are now offered to patients aged 75 – 79 years of age, and also pregnant patients who are 28 weeks or more in gestation. The RSV vaccine helps protect against respiratory syncytial virus (RSV).




We have started inviting eligible patients in for this vaccine, however, if you are eligible but have not yet been contacted please speak to Reception who can arrange this for you.

COVID VACCINE CLINICS

We have started running Saturday clinics for eligible patients to receive their COVID vaccines and inviting them in. These clinics are delivered by staff outside of working hours and in their free time.

Sometimes, delays can occur due to unexpected circumstances such as sickness, however, we work hard to ensure clinics are kept running as smoothly as possible. We appreciate patients understanding and consideration to this effect.





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DNAs (DID NOT ATTEND)

DNAs at the practice continue to be a growing problem. In August 2024 we had 368 appointments that weren't attended at either site, and in September 2024 we had 419. 150 of these appointments alone were for Phlebotomy (bloods). With so many DNAs, providing a fair service that works to full capacity becomes more of a difficult task for the practice and only impacts on other patients.

It is practice policy that if any appointment is not attended without being cancelled at least one hour before on more than 3 occasions, the patient will be struck off from the practice register.

There are various ways your appointment can be cancelled if you no longer require it such as:

- Texting "CANCEL" to your appointment reminder message
- Cancelling via NHS App / Patient Access
- Informing Reception via telephone or front desk

Appointments must be cancelled at least 1 hour in advance, so that the appointment may be given to another patient.

Stoptober

Even if it's your first time or you've tried before, Stoptober gives you the perfect opportunity to quit smoking.

With the right support, quitting is easier than you think.

Smokefree Knowsley are available locally over the phone or face to face. They have appointments at Towerhill Resource Centre on Tuesday mornings or Kirkby Library on Monday afternoons.

They offer a choice of NRT patches, mouth spray, gum, lozenges, inhalator, Zyban tablets and a vape through their partnership with Totally Wicked, or just support from an advisor if that is what is preferred.

Clients can have products for up to 12 weeks, and they will call or see patients every week to monitor their progress to hopefully being smoke free for good.
