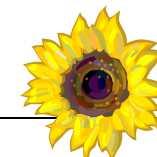

Travel vaccinations which are NOT available on the NHS are: Rabies; Japanese Encephalitis; Meningitis ACWY; Tick Borne Encephalitis; Hepatitis B (single agent); Yellow Fever.

We do not keep Rabies; Japanese Encephalitis; Meningitis ACWY; Tick Borne Encephalitis in stock. The cost of these this will be charged to the patient directly who will be required to pay for the cost of vaccine + administration fee of £60.00 per course of vaccinations in advance prior to the vaccine being ordered.
