Speaker-Claire Jameson (Project Manager) on Summary Care Record & Electronic Prescription Service. Summary Care Records are a snapshot of patient's records from GP system that can be accessed by out of hours and other health care providers. Patients received a letter in 2012 to opt out if they wanted. People can change their mind by informing their practice. Clinicians use an individual card which identifies who used the record. GP's have five different systems across Stockport, some GPs cannot upload the records including ours, but this will change after April. Concern was shown about details, assured that only care data items on record.

Electronic Prescription Service was started a few years ago can now be scanned electronically and sent to pharmacy of choice- do not need paper prescription. Informed works well for people on repeat medication. Discussion re problems. Presently Springfield not using this service.
