## **Urine Infections**

Urinary tract infections (UTIs) are common infections that affect the bladder, the kidneys and the tubes connected to them.

#### Who can help me with a UTI?

#### Health Centre ANP / GP

- All males
- Any blood in the urine
- Pain in lower back/temperature
- Symptoms longer than 7 days
- Recurrent infections (more than 2 in 6 months)
- Pregnancy
- Patients with catheters
- Patients aged 65 or over

#### **Your Local Pharmacy**

Females aged 16 and over and do not have any of the symptoms outlined above.

## **Prescriptions**

#### **Repeats**

Repeats are medications that the GP has authorised to be ordered frequently with routine checks by the GP.

#### **Acutes**

Acute prescriptions require a review by the GP on each occasion when ordered.

#### **Timeframe**

Prescriptions take 48 hours to process by the practice.

You also need to consider the time the Pharmacy need to dispense your prescription. This normally takes 2-3 days.
