Matter of the Moment:

Enhanced Access

Evening and weekend appointments are available at your GP practice or an NHS service nearby

This service is known as 'Enhanced Access' and is organised by your local Primary Care Network (PCN), these are groups of GP practices that work together to offer local services to their patients.

This service helps to make more appointments available for patients in the evenings and weekends when practices are fully booked. It also helps provide flexibility for patients who may need to arrange an appointment in the evening or at weekends if your practice is not open.

If you would prefer an evening or weekend appointment, please inform your practice of this when requesting an appointment, and they will try to arrange for you to be seen by the Enhanced Access Service where possible. You can also tell them if you prefer a telephone, video or face-to-face appointment.

At these appointments, you can see a health care professional, including a GP or a nurse, based on the nature of your issue. The healthcare professional may not be from your registered GP practice.
