Improved access to more local appointments

- Do you find it difficult to attend an appointment during the working day?
- Are you a busy parent with small children?
- Do you rely on people taking you to an appointment?

If so, you might be interested to hear about our new service **available from 1 October** providing some extra early morning, evening and Saturday appointments at one of our GP practices. This is an extension of your GP practice and will offer pre-bookable, routine appointments with GPs, nurses or other healthcare professionals and will be available to patients registered with a GP practice in the North of Doncaster.

This is not a walk-in or emergency service and you will need an appointment to be seen.

Location

All GP surgeries across the North of Doncaster. Availability of appointments will vary from practice to practice – you will be advised of availability when you call for an appointment.

How to book

Speak to your practice reception team to check availability and prebook an appointment. You can cancel or reschedule your appointment in the same way.

How will the service be staffed?

This will be a locally-led service with clinical and practice staff who already work in your local GP surgery and who you know and trust.

Opening times

Between 7.30 & 8 am and 6.30 to 8 pm Monday to Friday and 9 am to 5 pm on a Saturday. Availability of appointments will vary from practice to practice - you will be advised of availability when you call your practice to book an appointment.
