What is a Primary Care Network (PCN)?

A Primary Care Network coordinates care between their local populations and GP Practices, focussing on personalised care. We support the local community and focus on prevention and care that is personalised to the patient's needs. This means supporting patients to make informed decisions about their own health and care, connecting them to a wide range of services to ensure they can access the care they need.

Changes to Doncaster North From 1st April 2024

3 x GP Practices will move from Doncaster North to create the North West Primary Care Network.

Doncaster North — Arksey Lane Surgery, Askern Medical Practice, Denaby Medical Practice, Park View Surgery, Petersgate Medical Centre, Scawsby Health Centre, The Ransome Practice.

North West - Don Valley Healthcare, The Great North Medical Group and The Lakeside Practice.

We will update you on our website and social media as changes happen. These positive changes will allow each practice to focus on their patients needs.

What is Enhanced Access?

Enhanced Access are extra appointments provided with GP's, nurses and other health professionals at your practice. Please check with your GP Practice to find out which type of enhanced access they offer: morning, evening or Saturday appointments.

Enhanced Access appointments are via appointment only. *This is NOT a walk in emergency service.*

- Via NHS App (please contact us if you need support to get set up or use)

- Your GP Reception via phone or in person

Self examination - Can Save Your Life!

Cancer Alliance provided our Network with this self check awareness kit to be shared between the North GP Practices. This kit enables patients to gain a better idea of what a cancerous lump or skin lesion may look and feel like.

These kits have proved a great resource, especially in the Learning Disability community and care homes, as they can be used in conjunction with easy read material and demonstrations of how to check our own bodies for changes.

If something feels different and you are concerned, please contact your GP Practice and ask to see an appropriate clinician (GP or Nurse).



Following on from CRUK's Talk Cancer Workshop in January where members of our community came together to learn more about the importance of early cancer diagnosis, myth busting and how to reduce the risks of cancer. Our Care Co-ordinators Lisa and Tracie raised awareness at 'Let's Talk about Cancer Event, held on 23rd February in partnership with NDDT to raise awareness of talking about Cancer.





We understand Cancer can be scary, but by sharing knowledge, experiences and by attending available screening, exercising more, eating higher fibre foods, lower processed red meat, lower calorie food and drink we can work together to reduce the risk of Cancer.
