"Medicine Sick Day Guidance" Alert Card	Medicines that need medical advice if you are ill	
When you are unwell with any of the following: Vomiting and diarrhoea (unless very minor) Fevers, sweats and shaking Contact a medical professional, this may be your GP, Nurse or Pharmacist. If advised, STOP taking the medicines highlighted overleaf. Restart when you are well (usually 24-48 hours of eating and drinking normally)	ACE inhibitors	Medicines ending in "pril" eg. Lisinopril, perindopril, ramipril
	ARBs	Medicines ending in "sartan" eg. Losartan, candesartan, valsartan
	NSAIDs	Anti-inflammatory pain killers eg Ibuprofen, diclofenac, naproxen
	Diuretics	Sometimes called "water pills" eg Furosemide, spironolactone, bendroflumethiazide
	Diabetes	Metformin and "gliflozin's"
