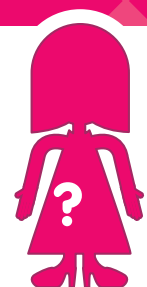

We want you to go, your health is important to us. We don't know how we'd manage without you.

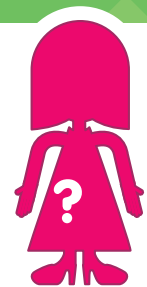


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Put your worry to rest by taking the test

I know it seems scary and you would rather not think about it, but going for regular screening is the best way to make sure everything is ok.



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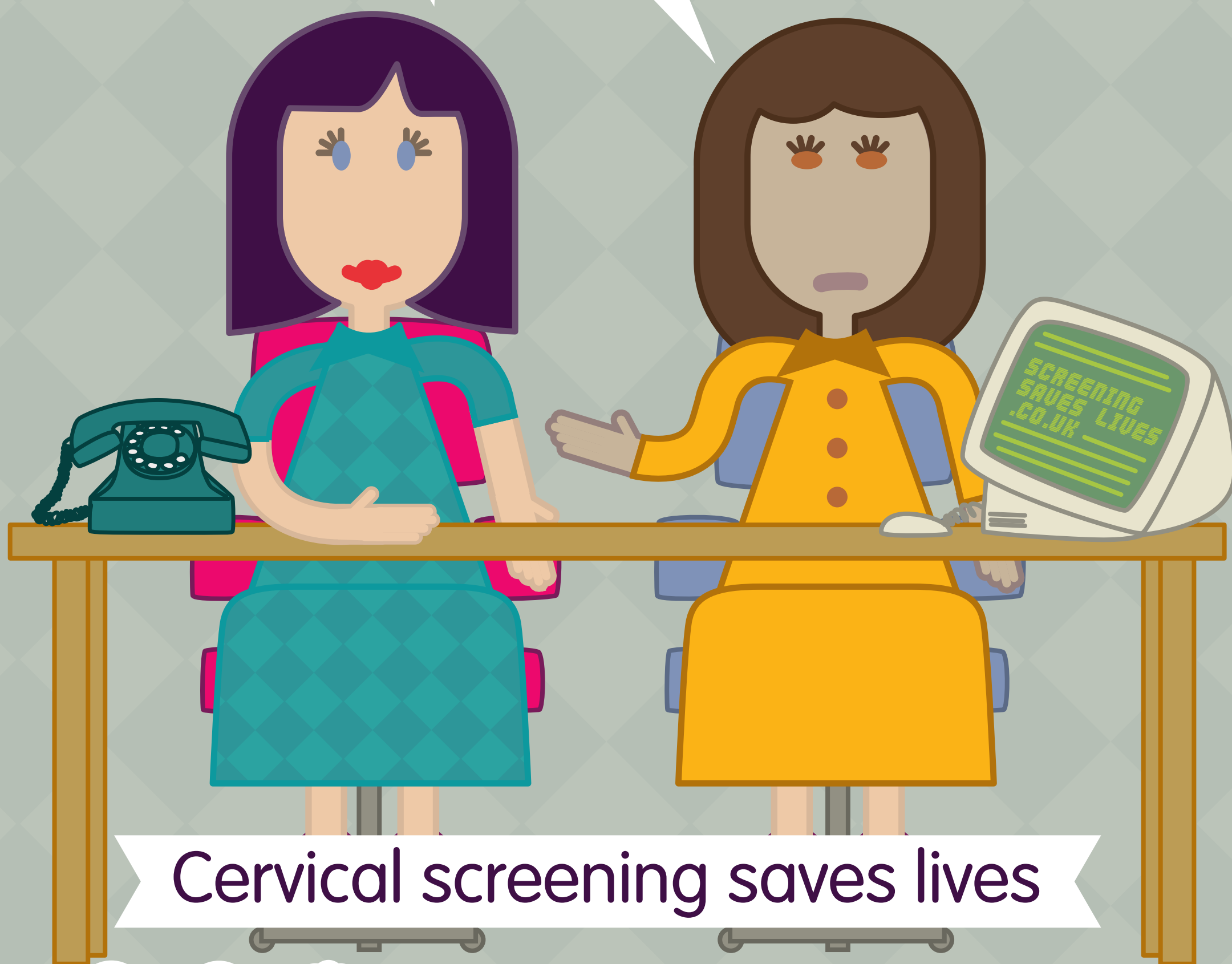
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Take the time to save your life
