What is Child Safeguarding?

Safeguarding means protecting children from physical, sexual, and emotional abuse, as well as neglect and abandonment, to help them grow up safely.

If you are ever worried about a child's safety or wellbeing, speak up – even small concerns matter.



What is Child Sexual Exploitation (CSE)

CSE happens when a child or young person is tricked, pressured, or forced into sexual activity - often in exchange for things like attention, money, or gifts It's never the child's fault. Help is available.
