Plain English explanation

Enhanced Data Sharing Model enables clinician to get a full picture of all elements that affect your care and treatment. This will allow out of hours and other healthcare providers to access your records. Initial consent is provided for your information to be shared however you can explicitly consent for a share in and out of each organisation.
