The NHS App allows you to access a range of NHS services online. To log in you need to have an NHS account, which can be set up using your email address and a password. You can log in through the NHS website of the NHS App, which is available on both iOS and Android devices. Once logged you can access services such repeat prescriptions, booking appointments and more.

Pharmacy First

The Pharmacy First scheme allows patients to get prescriptiononly medication for seven common conditions from their local community pharmacy without a GP appointment.

The seven conditions are: sinusitis, sore throat, earache, infected insect bite, impetigo, shingles, and uncomplicated urinary tract infections (UTIs) in women. Age restrictions apply for some conditions, and patients can access the service by walking in, contacting the pharmacy virtually, or being referred by a GP, NHS 111, or emergency care provider.
