For emergency contraception, PEP, under-18s, and sexual assault patients can walk in.

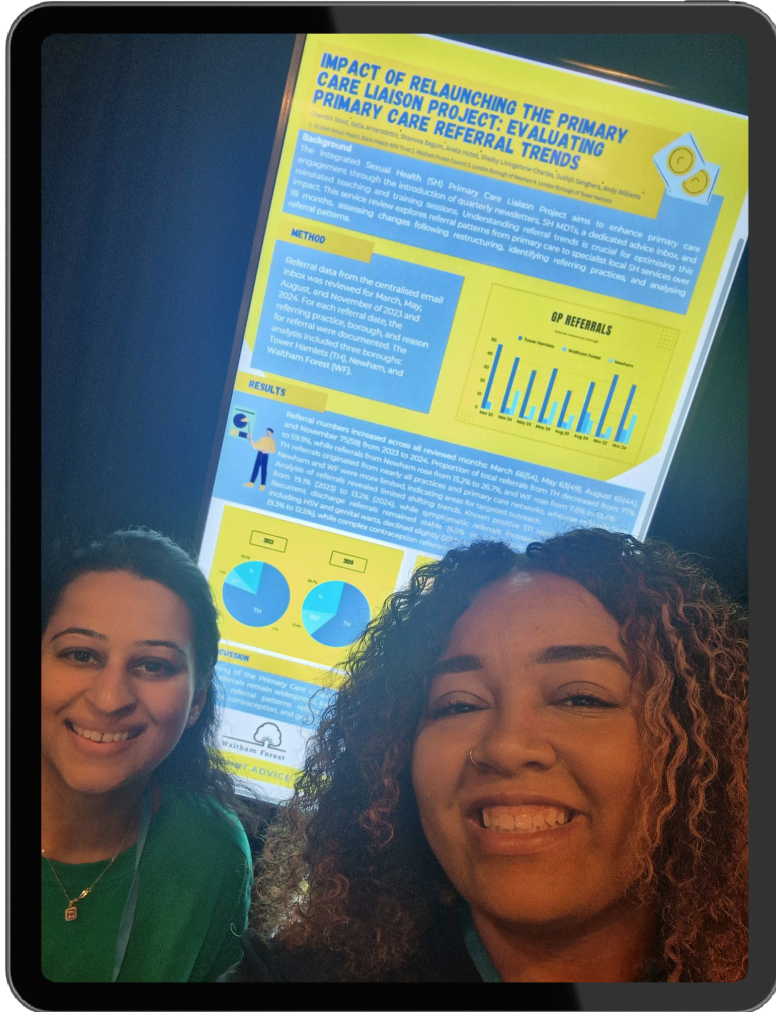
