WHO SHOULD I SEE FOR MY PROBLEM?

We operate as an integral team within the practice and in many cases the most suitable person for you to see is not the doctor. Please be prepared to give the reception staff a brief reason for any appointment request so that they can book you in to the most appropriate clinic or signpost you to a more appropriate service.

Advanced Nurse Practitioner, Physicians Associate & Nurse Prescribers, Physiotherapists

Can see patients with a wide range of illnesses and injuries and, if it is needed, they can provide a prescription.

Practice Nurses or Healthcare Assistant

Management of chronic disease including heart disease, diabetes, asthma, high blood pressure, well man and woman checks, immunisations and routine tests such as smears, blood pressure checks and blood tests.

Pharmacist

Our practice pharmacist can deal with medication queries and patients may be booked to see/speak with them for medication reviews.

Health Visitors - Advice and monitoring of children under 5, advice re immunisations, feeding, behaviour, etc.

Midwives - all aspects of ante-natal care. Midwife appointments are not held at the practice but you will be offered an appointment at a location close to where you live.

School Nurses - Advice and monitoring of school age children, bed wetting, immunisations, emotional support.

Dentists - your local dentist can deal with dental problems and also problems with the mouth and gums.
