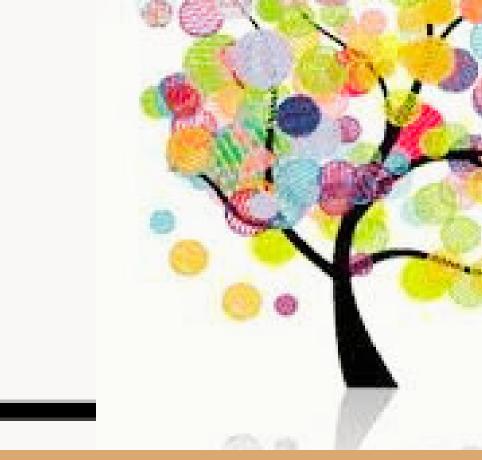

#### ALCOHOL AWARENESS MONTH

Drinking too much alcohol regularly can lead to several preventable health complications like liver disease, heart problems, brain dysfunction and much more.

Current guidelines suggest you should be drinking no more than 14 units a week, spread over at least 3 days.

That's around 6 standard glasses of wine, or 4 pints of beer.



In England, there are an estimated 602,391 dependent drinkers, with only 18% receiving treatment. In 2015/16, 39% of all violent incidents were due to the offender being under the influence of alcohol.

In 2019/20, 74,618 people were in treatment at specialist alcohol misuse services.

- book and manage appointments

- view your health record securely

# Help protect your baby with the whooping cough vaccine

There is a lot of whooping cough around at the moment. Babies are at most risk, especially in their first weeks of life.

If you have reached 20 weeks of pregnancy or later and have not yet been offered the whooping cough vaccine, talk to your midwife or GP practice and make an appointment to get vaccinated.

#### Don't take the risk.

Act now to protect your baby against whooping cough from birth. Contact your GP or midwife to get the vaccination.

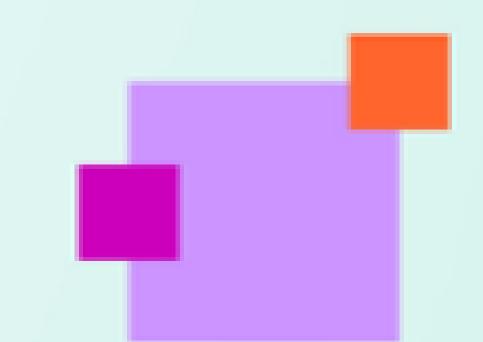

Most pharmacies can help you with seven common conditions without needing a GP appointment



- Sinusitis (adults and children aged 12 years and over)
- Sore throat (adults and children aged 5 years and over)
- Earache (children and young adults aged 1 year to 17 years)
- Infected insect bite (adults and children aged 1 year and over)
- Impetigo (adults and children aged 1 year and over)
- Shingles (adults aged 18 years and over)
- Urinary tract infection (women, aged 16 to 64 years)

If you have any symptoms from the above list, let the pharmacy know and they will be able to

examine you.
