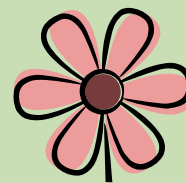

Dr Sudam Prabhu: Monday, Tuesday, Wednesday and Friday (am only)

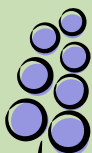
Dr Mike Mannion: Monday, Wednesday, Thursday and Friday
