

- ⇒ This may be a same-day telephone call, a face-to-face appointment, advice by text, or referral to another service.

Please allow **72 hours** for your repeat prescription to be ready (this does not include weekends and Bank holidays) **It needs to be dropped off before 2pm (Mon-Fri)** to guarantee the 72 hour turn around. Please note drop off is 12pm on a Tuesday at Orleton Surgery.

If you order online, please indicate which surgery you would like to collect from. Dispensary is **closed** Saturdays, Sundays and Bank Holidays.

If you need a prescription earlier than planned please let dispensary know.
