- UTIs (women aged 16–64)

Flu Vaccine Eligibility – Winter 2025/26

Protect yourself and others this winter. The **free NHS** flu vaccine is available to eligible groups starting **September 1, 2025**, with expanded access from **October 1**.

- 🔰 Pregnant women
- School-aged children (Reception-Year 11)
- © Children 6 months–17 years with long-term conditions
- Adults 65+

- Adults 18–64 in clinical risk groups
- Care home residents
- Mathematics Carers and household contacts of immunocompromised individuals
- Frontline health and social care workers
- Get vaccinated at your GP surgery, pharmacy, maternity service, care home, or workplace.

COVID-19 Vaccine Eligibility – Winter 2025/26

The **free NHS COVID-19 vaccine** is available to the following eligible people:

- aged 75 or over (including those who will be 75 by 31 January 2026)
- aged 6 months to 74 years and have a weakened immune system because of a health condition or treatment
- live in a care home for older adults
