NHS APP

The nhs app is a quick and effect way to access your medical records as well as the below:

- Order repeat prescriptions and nominate a pharmacy where you would like to collect them.
- Book and manage appointments.
- View your GP health record to see information like your allergies and medicines (if your GP has given you access to your detailed medical record, you can also see information like test results)
- Book and manage COVID-19 vaccinations.

- Aged 75 years and over
- Immunosuppressed due to an illness/treatment
- Resident in a care home for older adults.
