### Your 8am Just Got Easier!

Starting Monday, 8th September 2025, we're excited to launch our new Rapid Health online triage system!

With Rapid Health, you can:

- Skip the phone queue!
- Access appointments & make requests between 8am -6:30pm!
- Request sick notes, enquire about test results, and order medication - all online!

It only takes about 5 minutes to complete, and you'll either be offered an appointment or flagged for triage.

No online access? Call us! Our reception team will complete the form for you.

Please be aware that using the telephone will not speed up your request, as all appointment queries follow the same process.

Get started on Monday, 8th September 2025, and experience easier healthcare! Until then, please continue to use our current online service as normal.

Use the touch screen in reception to check in for your appointment quickly and easily. Just follow the on-screen instructions - no need to wait in line!



Accessing oral contraception is now quicker, easier, and more convenient than ever.

Thanks to the NHS community pharmacy oral contraception service, you can now get the contraceptive pill for free, directly from your local pharmacy, without needing a prescription or an appointment with your GP. Whether you're starting contraception for the first time or need a repeat supply, your local pharmacist is here to help.

The service is delivered by trained pharmacists in a private consultation room. Everything you discuss is confidential, and your pharmacist will talk through your options and check your health to make sure the pill is right for you.

### **HPV Vaccine Catch-Ups for Ages 16-25**

If you missed your HPV vaccine at school (usually given in Year 8), you can still get it up to your 25<sup>th</sup> Birthday. The vaccine protects against HPV, a common infection that can cause certain cancers.

# How We'll Contact You Following a Referral

If you're referred through the Electronic Referral System (ERS) and have an NHS login, we'll email your paperwork directly to you.

If you don't have an NHS login but we have your mobile number, we'll send you a text with a link to view your paperwork.

Printing and posting your documents will only be used as a last resort.

#### Did you know?

The NHS App lets you get messages from your GP and hospital, order prescriptions and see your medical records - all on your phone. It's easy to use and worth trying!
