
WHAT IS A PRIMARY CARE NETWORK (PCN)?

Since the NHS was created in 1948, the population has grown and people are living longer, often with one of more long term health conditions.

To meet these needs, in 2018 the Government grouped GP practices together on natural geographic footprints and called them Primary Care Networks or PCNs.

Simply, the aim of PCNs is to build resilience and increase capacity across primary care (GP practices). PCNs have introduced new roles and services to GP Practices (in addition to the existing workforce) to best serve the needs of the individual PCN populations. They also work at scale and offer shared services to our whole population so everyone has equal access to services.

There are 1,250 PCNs in England! PCNs vary in size, typically they are 30,000 to 50,00 in population. One Ellesmere Port PCN has a patient population of approximately 72,300 and rising!
