

# KEEPING WELL IN WINTER

Cold weather can affect anyone, but some people are at higher risk, such as older adults, young children, those with long-term health conditions, low mobility, or who live alone.

#### Why cold weather matters:

Cold homes, damp, and poor insulation can increase the risk of illness. Winter also brings more infections such as flu and COVID-19, and icy conditions can lead to slips and falls. Faulty or unsafe heating can cause carbon monoxide poisoning, so it's important to keep your home both warm and safe.

#### **TIPS**

- Reduce Draughts with draught excluders
- Eat regular hot meal and drink hot drinks where possible
- Get your flu & Covid 19 vaccination (if eligible)
- · Wear shoes with good grip when going outside
- Make sure you have enough of your medication incase bad weather makes it difficult to go out
- Check if you're eligible for Winter Fuel Payments
  and other local energy efficiency grants


