#### GP Patient Survey 2025



The Meeting discuss the results above. It was noted that the completion rate of the GP Patient Survey was 33% (124 Surveys sent back). The Good overall experience of this GP Practice was 65% and helpfulness of Reception and Administrative Team at this GP Practice was 81%.

The Practice Manager discussed appointment access in the practice had increased by one GP session per week and every month a Sessional GP was delivering two patients follow up clinics. The Practice Manager advised that patients were utilising the patient call back services that was now available on the new telephone system.

The Practice Manager also discussed that although the practice has already been providing online routine consultation for administration and medical requests, this would be mandatory from October 2025. The practice was unsure patient demand would be for this and how the practice would manage staffing resources for both telephone and online consultations requests. The practice was considering Total Triage patient models and were going to undertake the Nottingham and Nottinghamshire Integrated Care Board GP Improvement Programme, which helps practices access and capacity demands. The Programme is due to start in September 2025.
