

Transport factsheet



The Council invests in over 120 services across Nottinghamshire, including services with fixed routes and timetables, Demand Responsive Transport which has no fixed timetable or route, but still enables residents to travel from bus stop to bus stop in a certain geographical area. The Council also invests with partners in bus stops, passenger information and real time information. These services will transfer to the Mayor and East Midlands County Combined Authority by April 2026.
