Cranbrook Surgery offers an online consultation platform called AccurX-https://accurx.nhs.uk/patient-initiated/f86698. Patients can submit non urgent clinical as well as administrative queries through the portal.

What can you use it for?

- Ask a question about a health concern or non-urgent appointment request
- Acute medication requests
- Travelling abroad need vaccination and advice
- · Follow up on results or treatment
- Requesting letters, forms to be filled or any other admin requests
- Request admin help (e.g. sick note extension)
- Update your GP about your symptoms
- Send a photo (if requested by the surgery)

Nhen NOT to use the form

- Emergencies If life is in danger (e.g. chest pain, stroke) call 999
- Urgent help needed now Use 111.nhs.uk or call 111
- Need an Urgent appointments for the Acute medical conditions please ring the surgery

How does it work?

- 1. **Go online** GP surgery website- https://accurx.nhs.uk/patient-initiated/f86698) or the NHS App and click the link.
- 2. Fill in the form Answer some simple questions about your query.
- 3. **Submit** Check your details and send the form.
- 4. **Get a reply** You'll receive a confirmation message, and the GP team will review your request. You should get a response either same day or within **2 working days**.

NHS App

The NHS App gives you a simple and secure way to access a range of NHS services. Download the NHS App on your smartphone or tablet via the <u>Google play</u> or <u>App store</u>. You can also access the same services in a web browser by <u>logging in through the NHS</u> website.

You must be aged 13 or over to use the NHS App. You also need to be registered with a GP surgery in England or the Isle of Man. Find out more about who can use the NHS App.

What the NHS App does

- Prescriptions: Request repeat prescriptions and nominate a pharmacy for collection.
- Appointments: Book, view, and manage appointments with your GP surgery and hospitals.
- Health Records: Access your GP and hospital health records, including allergies, medicines, and some test results.
- NHS Number: Find and view your NHS number.
- Organ Donation: Register or update your decision about organ donation.
- 111 Online: Use NHS 111 online for instant advice and to get help near you.
- Data Preferences: Control how the NHS uses your personal data.
- GP Messages: Receive messages and notifications from your GP surgery.
