You are probably already aware of our value in delivering solutions that help tackle loneliness and isolation before they become a wider and costlier issue for services.

We'd now like to share our plans for doing even more...

Our very own Warm Welcome Groups are already a resounding success,

firstly in Rudheath, now in Winsford and soon also in Crewe.

Where appropriate, we are having the conversations with our referred service users to see if they can safely attend these weekly groups, to enjoy a freshly prepared lunch and socialise in a warm and welcoming, supervised environment.

With the limited funding we have, we'd like to do even more... but how...?

We know that a face-to-face provision can have a massive impact, we also understand that many of our service users may face challenges in accessing the locations above.

That is why we have spent a great deal of time, researching and curating our own directory of groups, events and venues right across cheshire, to ensure that we can now offer every suitable individual the opportunity to enjoy regular social interaction on a new level from April 28th, 2025.

Our telephone befriending provision will continue to offer a vital service for those unable to leave their homes, however, if a service user is a suitable candidate, and keen to try something new, then in conjunction with our county-wide team of befriending volunteers......

We will do everything we can to empower them to do so!













Ray has been attending the group for almost a year.

He joined because he felt lonely and needed company after losing his wife.

When asked if the group fulfils his reasons for attending, Ray said 'Yes, very, very nice people, good company and I enjoy it'.

He is always keen to join in with conversations and enjoys the quizzes and games. He likes to be included in the photographs each week and his daughter enjoys seeing him on our social media posts!

Ray said before attending the group he felt very lonesome, and it took some time to adjust after his loss.

During the session, Ray said 'I feel good. Very nice people and I have made friends who I'd never have met. I enjoy the company of all the volunteers and Julie who runs it'.

Ray said that attending the group changes his week, and he really looks forward to it.


