### **Feedback Summary**

#### **Question 1: Scale of 1-5, how did you enjoy the story?**

- Responses: 4x (4), 5x (5)
- Overall, attendees rated the story positively, with most giving a 5/5.

#### **Question 2: Did the story help you to learn new things about asthma?**

- Responses: 2x (3), 4x (5)
- Most children indicated that they learned new things about asthma, with the majority rating their learning experience at the highest level.

#### **Question 3: After hearing the story, do you feel more confident about understanding asthma?**

- **Yes:** 5 responses
- **Somewhat:** 1 response
- **No:** 0 responses
- **Additional Comments:**
  - Especially about the 10 puffs of the blue inhaler during an asthma attack.

#### **Question 4: What was your favourite part of the story?**

- Where you could join in.
- Coughing segment.
- Loved the props and participation – very informative. Great initiative.
- When I could give the wolf the inhaler.
- Info about the different inhalers – loved the puppets.
- Showing the children how to use the inhaler.

### **Overall Feedback & Recommendations**

- The event was well received, with high engagement and enjoyment levels.
- Children particularly enjoyed interactive elements, such as using props and participating in the story.
- The educational component was effective, with most children gaining a better understanding of asthma management, particularly the use of inhalers.
- Future sessions could enhance participation by incorporating more role-play activities and hands-on demonstrations.
