Appointment Information

- To book an appointment with us, you can use **askmyGP**, our user-friendly online system.
- Alternatively, you can call our receptionists at **0161 748 2021**.
- Whether you choose to contact us online or by phone, your GP will promptly address your concerns, either through a phone call, secure message, or by scheduling an in-person visit on the same or a convenient day.

Extended Hours

- For additional appointments during evenings and weekends, our patients can see a GP, Nurse, or Phlebotomist.
- This service is available from 18:30 to 20:00, Monday to Friday, and from 9:00 am to 5 pm on Saturdays.

Out of hours

- If you require medical assistance outside our regular hours, use **NHS 111 online** or **call 111**.
- For children under 5, **call 111**.
- In a medical or mental health emergency, **dial 999**.
- Trafford General Hospital Walk-in Centre is open every day from 8:00 am to 8:00 pm.

Home Visits

- If you need a home visit, please call before 11:30 am.
- Home visits are reserved for housebound patients or those too unwell to visit the practice.

- If you reside in our practice area with the M41 postcode, within the M60 ring road, you can book an appointment with the Practice Nurse. Feel free to call or visit our surgery for additional information.

Repeat Prescriptions:

Prescription requests are not taken via AskMyGP. We have other options for ordering repeat and urgent medications, and we need 72 hours' notice. You can order through:

- Use your NHS account (via the NHS website or NHS App).
- Order through our GP online system at <https://www.patientaccess.com/>.
- Email: gmicb-tr.scripts.frmc@nhs.net.
- In-person or drop off at the practice.
- Ask your nominated pharmacy to request on your behalf. You can nominate a pharmacy at the surgery or your chosen pharmacy.

Test Results

- We can usually only give information about a test results directly to the patient.
