What the NHS App does

- order repeat prescriptions see your available medicines, request a new repeat prescription and choose a pharmacy for your prescriptions to be sent to.
- book appointments search for, book and cancel appointments at your GP surgery, and see details of your upcoming and past appointments.
- check your symptoms search trusted NHS information and advice on hundreds of conditions and treatments, and get instant advice
 or medical help near you.
- register your organ donation decision choose to donate some or all of your organs and check your registered decision.
- find out how the NHS uses your data choose if data from your health records is shared for research and planning.
- view parts of your GP record including information about medication, allergies, vaccinations, previous illnesses and test results.
