Contact your GP practice online

Winter can be a challenging time for health services, and with the bank holidays just weeks away, we want to make sure everyone knows where to go for the care they need. Here are a few important tips to keep in mind:



- **Check your repeat prescriptions:** Do you take regular medication on repeat prescription? If so, take a moment to check how much you have at home. If you need to order more, be sure to put your request in at least **two weeks** before you expect to run out. This will help avoid any delays or complications during the busy holiday period.
- **Pharmacists are here to help:** Did you know that your local pharmacist can offer expert advice on treating minor illnesses or injuries? Whether it's a sore throat or your child is teething, your community pharmacy can provide support without an appointment. They can also recommend over-the-counter medicines or even prescribe medication for certain conditions. Just remember to check their **bank holiday opening times!**
- **Not sure which NHS service to use?** When you use the right NHS service, you'll get the care you need more quickly. If you're ever unsure where to go, visit **111.nhs.uk** for advice. It's available **24/7, 365 days a year** to guide you to the right care.
- **Urgent care:** Need urgent help? Whether it's dental pain, sudden changes in your vision, or a mental health crisis, there are local services ready to help. Know where to go for **urgent and emergency services** by the NHS website or calling NHS 111.
