1. Minutes from 31st July meeting agreed as a true record.
2. Matters arising
CPR Training – Paediatric 9/8/25 – 15 came to the training. A request to do an in-depth De-fib training in 2026.

4. Chairs report
 - a) Since last AGM we have supported the practice in the flu vaccines and will do again this year.

5. Ryedale leg club
A community club for lower leg ulcers to be held at Pickering Recreation Club on a Monday morning. The idea is members (not called patients) to come together as a club and not an outpatient. A social gathering which will have no appointments but a drop-in session. It will have a social element to the club.

6. Practice and Staff updates.

a) Funding available to do re-furnishment of next door to the practice. This can be used as a stand-alone hub. More details to follow on how it will work. Hopefully work starting in October 2025.

b) Staff – fully staffed. Admin – some sickness and maternity leave.

There have been issues across the ICB with IT but it is now resolved.

c) Flu jabs - Oct 3rd and 24th 8:40 – 6pm. PPG will help on day.

d) Ultrasound run by York Health Solutions are no longer coming to the practice as the contact has been moved to Community Diagnostic clinics that have been set up with the closest in Malton.

7. PCN news

Looking at more staff and continuity of care – looking at early cancer diagnosis.

8. Future speakers.

Several suggestions for 2026 to be looked at including the practice social prescribers.

9. Future meetings
