AccuRX Total Triage – Online Booking

- A presentation was given on the new **Total Triage and online access system**, due to start at the end of January 2025.
- Key points discussed:
 - Patients without internet access can still call the practice; reception staff will complete the form on their behalf.
 - Reception remains available to answer calls.
 - Nurse appointments will continue to be booked as usual.
 - Staff will be available at the front desk to help patients complete online forms.
 - Patients do not need to register for online services or use the NHS app.
 - Opening times for the online system will be shared and advertised.

- A patient information leaflet and FAQs were reviewed, with suggestions for clearer wording.
 - Members were asked to share feedback and patient concerns with the practice team.

Any Other Business

- A member suggested creating a **leaflet for patients living alone** to help them prepare for operations or recovery.
