# **King Edward Road Surgery**

Patient Participation Group (PPG) Meeting Summary

Date: 15th July 2025

### **Previous Minutes**

- Minutes from the May 2025 meeting were agreed.
- New members were welcomed and introduced to the role of the PPG.

### **Chair and Vice Chair**

- The responsibilities of the PPG Chair were discussed, including:
  - Input into meeting agendas.
  - o Liaison with the Practice Manager between meetings.
  - o Supporting inspections (e.g., CQC) and patient surveys.
- A Vice Chair was confirmed, with unanimous agreement from the group.
- The Chairperson role remains under discussion.

#### **FeNO Machine**

- The FeNO machine was discussed as a diagnostic tool for asthma.
- It measures nitric oxide levels in exhaled breath, indicating airway inflammation.
- Suitable for adults and most children over five.
- As spirometry services are unavailable, the FeNO machine would support diagnosis.
- Book sale funds will contribute towards the purchase.
- The PPG agreed to allocate additional funds towards the cost.
- Note: Mouthpieces are an additional ongoing cost to the practice.

### **Veterans and Armed Forces Covenant**

- The practice records patients who have served in the armed forces as part of its **RCGP accreditation**.
- The **Armed Forces Covenant** ensures fair treatment and priority access to healthcare for veterans where conditions relate to their service, subject to clinical need.
- NHS England commissions specialist services for serving personnel, families, and veterans.
- Action: To confirm whether veterans of the **South African Air Force (SAAF)** are included under the Covenant.

### **Carers Silver Award**

- Work is ongoing towards achieving the **Silver Carers Award**, with the aim of progressing to Gold and Gold Plus.
- The importance of identifying carers and young carers was highlighted.
- PPG members were asked to encourage patients who are carers to register with the practice.
- Volunteers from the PPG will assist in the practice by speaking to patients and distributing carers' information packs.

## **National Patient Survey**

- Results from 2024 were reviewed.
- The 2025 results had been released and will be presented at the next meeting.
- A short patient survey will also be sent to patients who have attended the practice.

## **Total Triage Discussion**

- Ouestions raised included:
  - o Could triage be reopened in the afternoon?
  - The current 4-hour callback window is considered too long; could technology provide estimated callback times?
- Action: Practice Manager to review options.
- A patient survey will be arranged in August, with PPG members assisting.

## **Any Other Business**

- **CQC Inspection**: Another local practice will be inspected shortly; compliance and shared building arrangements were discussed.
- **Primary Care Network (PCN)**: An overview was given for new members, including member practices and staff roles (pharmacists, physiotherapists, paramedics, wellbeing team, social prescribers).
- **Book Donations**: Members encouraged to bring in donations and ask family and friends.
