How your information is used

When applying to join our Patient Participation Group (PGG) we ask applicants to provide the following personal data:

- Name
- Address
- Telephone Number
- Age
- Gender
- Whether you are a patient at the GP Practice
- · Whether you are a carer

Your information helps us to ensure that the membership group reflects the patient profile and be widely representative and inclusive of different genders, ethnicities, ages and abilities.

Will we only process your personal data with your consent in line with the UK General Data Protection Regulation (UK GDPR).

Who your information is shared with

- GP Practice Manager
- Patient Participation Group Committee

The lawful basis for sharing your information

The purpose for sharing your information between the GP Practice and PGG Committee is to manage the PGG membership.

The lawful basis for processing your personal data is UK GDPR Article 6(1)(a) – the data subject has given consent to the processing of his or her personal data for one or more specific purposes.

And for special category data, UK GDPR Article 9(2)(a) – the data subject has given explicit consent to the processing of those personal data for one or more specified purposes.

About your rights to see or change information held about you

You have the right to find out what information the GP Practice and PPG Committee hold about you, ask them to correct it if it is wrong or delete it, by contacting the GP Practice Manager.
