This plan explains how we make our building easy to use for everyone.

55. Getting Here

- Our practice is in Leeds city centre, near the bus station.
- There is no parking at the practice, but if you have a Blue Badge, you can use nearby public parking spaces.

Entering the Building

- The practice is on the ground floor.
- There is a **small ramp inside** the building.
- The SAS entrance has two steps. We have a portable ramp – please ask when you book your appointment.
- The building does not have automatic doors.

Moving Around Inside

- Corridors are wide enough for wheelchairs.
- Signs are easy to read and have pictures and words.

H Facilities

- There are two toilets for patients.
 - One toilet is accessible for people with disabilities.
- There is a baby changing area.

- We have an induction loop at reception for hearing aids.
- We can give you large print information if you ask.

Help for People with Learning Disabilities

- We have Easy Read leaflets and letters.
- You can have extra time for your appointment.
- You can bring someone with you for support.
