Infection Control Statement

The Practice is committed to infection control to provide a safe environment to all staff, patients and visitors. Our policies and procedures outline our commitment to the control of infection and these arrangements are in line with local and national standards within the NHS.

Our statement includes:

- Dr N Jaiveloo is the clinical lead for the surgery and is assisted by the Practice Nurses and Practice Manager; infection control is the responsibility of all staff working in the practice;
- The practice undertakes to keep the surgery clean and tidy and the surgery is cleaned daily to ensure the premises meet the highest possible infection control standards;
- Our GP's and nurses take all responsible steps to reduce infection risk and ensure that equipment used meets the required standards.
- We encourage staff and patients to raise any issues or report any incidents relating to cleanliness and infection control. Through our reporting procedures we can identify any issues and make improvements to avoid future problems.
- Infection control inspections and audits are carried out to make sure our infection control procedures are working;
- Staff receive updates and training on cleanliness and infection control;
- Our policies and procedures are reviewed regularly to ensure they are robust and meet local and national guidance.
