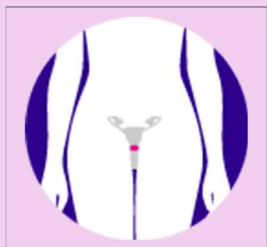

CERVICAL CANCER AWARENESS MONTH



Cervical cancer is when abnormal cells in the lining of the cervix grow in an uncontrolled way. The cervix is part of the female reproductive system. It is the opening to the vagina from the womb. The main symptoms unusual bleeding from the vagina. Finding changes in the cells through screening can help to prevent cancer developing.

The most common symptoms of cervical cancer include:

- unusual vaginal bleeding
- pain or discomfort during sex
- vaginal discharge
- pain in the area between the hip bones (pelvis)
