

Flu Vaccine for Children Aged 2 and 3



Flu is a **virus** that can make children very poorly.

Protection



The Flu vaccine can **protect your child** and **stop them spreading flu** to your family and friends.

symptoms











Symptoms of Flu include:

- Finding it hard to breathe
- Aching body
- A sore throat
- A cough
- A temperature above 38 degrees Celsius

Age 2 or 3



If your child is aged **2 or 3 years old** on the 31st August 2025 their flu vaccination will be due in the **September**.

Nasal spray



The flu vaccine is usually given as a **spray into the nose**.

This is called a **nasal spray**. It is **quick**, **safe** and **easy** to have and **does not hurt**.

Possible side effects



Side effects from the vaccine are usually **not serious**.

Sometimes your child might get a runny or blocked nose, headache, feel tired or not want to eat as much.

Not everyone gets side effects.



The flu vaccine is **free**.
