5.	Staffing: AW, KB and RC shared that one of the ST2 medical students Dr Isaiah has completed his time with us and has moved onto Two Rivers. Dr Okoluku ST3 has another 6 months at the Grove. Dr Okoluku is progressing really well and consulting with patients every day. The students have a dedicated clinical supervisor each day to discuss patients with and carry out de-briefs.  We were lucky enough to host 4 additional medical students throughout October and December and are looking to increase the numbers of students learning at the surgery in the coming months.
