## Important information about your GP practice

Dear Patient.

We wanted to make you aware of a potential relocation from our current address to a new site at Saddlers Shopping Centre, Bridgeman Street, Walsall, WS1 1PL (the new site is 1 minute walk from Saddlers Centre bus station).

As you may know, our current premises were adapted from a retail shop. The building is not easily accessible for patients/staff with mobility issues and does not have the space we need to provide patient care effectively or increase the range of services we offer.

We are proposing a move to a spacious, modified surgery, 0.8 mile away Bridgeman Street. While the move would impact those patients living close to our current site more, it would mean we could improve services for all in the future.

Under the proposal, our catchment area would remain unchanged and current staff retained. We would also maintain the name of Palfrey Health Centre.

We'd like to hear your views on how this potential move would impact you. There are a number of different ways you can give your feedback;
