1. Apologies: None

2. Welcome: Louise opened the meeting & was pleased to welcome Kathy Cairns, a new PPG volunteer. All PPG members introduced themselves & gave a brief mention of their background

3. Minutes & Matters Arising:

The minutes of the meeting held on the 8 April had been circulated and were taken as read. There were no matters arising.

4. Practice Manager's Report:

- (i) Staff levels. Jennie advised that one of the receptionists was retiring & a replacement had not been recruited. Current staff were covering her hours on a three month trial for which they will be paid. A Health Care Assistant & Nurse were on maternity leave & cover for them had been organised. An additional Nurse had been recruited to deal with smear tests.
- (ii) Training. Jennie reported that all training is on target.
- (iii) Appointments & Did Not Attend (DNA) Jennie confirmed that between April & June there had been 11,320 of which 250 were DNAs, equating to 2.2% overall. This was not considered to be an issue however the situation will be kept under review. Action: Jennie Jennie confirmed that extended access appointments for specialist needs continue to be available at the hub.
- (iv) Complaints. Jennie advised that since April there had been 11 complaints.
- (v) CQC. Jennie confirmed that this remains ongoing with further communication still awaited.
- (vi) Systems. Jennie advised that the change over to the new telephone system had been very smooth with positive feedback It will be kept under constant review. Action: Jennie to keep under review. The Practice now has 5,570 patients with numbers increasing all the time.
- 5. Care Co-ordinator's Report. Fiona reported on the work with which she is involved.
- (i) The Bereavement Group continues to run every 2 weeks and has 2 new members. Fiona believed that this could gradually tail off & restart at a later date.
- (ii) The Veterans Group attended a special service to mark the 80th Anniversary of D Day. The next coffee morning would take place in September

- (iii) Care Homes Both Clanfield Care Home & Hermitage House Care Home reported that they were very happy with all the support the Practice gives to them.
- **6. ENPA Report.** Louise briefly reported on the work of ENPA (East Northants PPG Association) to bring new member, Kathy Cairns, up to date. Basically local representatives meet with PPG members from 8 local practices to identify, discuss and raise important issues to a higher level to be addressed.
