Minutes of 4th PPG (Patient Participation Group)

Introduction

Guest Speaker: Local Independent Pharmacy

A local pharmacist attended offering an insight into their services. He explained that due to dispensing licensing they can only deliver medicines and not dispense items to patients on the premises.

Services offered by them include:

- Patients can dispose of medications with them but not used needles or sharps for which patients need to contact their local Council. (See below)
- They offer a new medication and follow up service for patients starting new medications. In addition to this they receive discharge summaries from local hospitals, for those patients registered with them. They will then contact the patient to make sure they understand the changes to their medication.

They offer telephone or video link consultations for:

- Sinusitis
- Shingles

- Uncomplicated UTIs
- Sore throat
- Insect bites
- Impetigo
- Contraceptive (ongoing) pill check and can check their blood pressure.
- They can give advice and start female patients on contraceptive pills (16 years and over)
- Emergency contraception/morning after pill is now available free of charge

They cannot examine ears for infections. (This service might be available at larger chemists).

Private Services are also available (for which there is a charge):

- Travel clinic
- Weight management treatments (including Mounjaro)
- Menstrual period delay
- Erectile disfunction treatment

Guest Speaker: Afoma – Clinical Pharmacist at The Hamilton Practice

Afoma gave a talk on some of the things she does in her role of Pharmacist. She carries out Medication Reviews with patients, focusing on optimizing medicines in line with current guidelines as well as reviewing and reduce harm from prescribed medicines. Until recently all these appointments have been carried out over the telephone, however she does now offer some face-to-face appointments.

Patient Survey
